+10% growth in overseas visitors and +9% growth in revenue for January-September 2016

Today's figures from the CSO (Central Statistics Office) confirm visitors from overseas grew by +10% during January-September 2016 – that's almost 600,000 additional arrivals compared to the same nine-month period in 2015.

Revenue grew by +9% during this period, an additional €304 million compared with the first nine months of 2015. Holiday visitors grew by +9%, about 287,000 additional holiday visitors.
