## **Enniskillen's Blakes of the Hollow is the latest site of our Game of Thrones® campaign**

It's week four of HBO's blockbuster show which means Tourism Ireland has just revealed a new Game of Thrones® door – this time in the atmospheric surrounds of Blakes of the Hollow pub in Enniskillen.

Each week, to coincide with season six, we are unveiling a new door, depicting scenes and stories from the latest episode. Our aim is to remind fans around the world that nowhere will get them closer to Game of Thrones® than Northern Ireland – the home of countless GoT locations, including Dragonstone, the Haunted Forest and Winterfell. The doors have been created using wood from trees felled by Storm Gertrude at County Antrim's iconic Dark Hedges (or Kingsroad in Game of Thrones®).



The first door (from episode one) is hanging in The Cuan guest inn in Strangford – near the filming locations of Castle Ward and Audley's Castle. The second door is hanging in Fiddlers Green in Portaferry, near Quintin Bay. The third door, in the Percy French restaurant, is near Tollymore Forest Park.
