Tourism Ireland welcomes growth of +7.1% in overseas visitors for January-October 2018

Today's figures from the CSO indicate that overseas visitor arrivals increased by +7.1% during the January-October period – 605,300 additional arrivals when compared with the first ten months of 2017.

North America, Mainland Europe and Australia and emerging markets continued to perform strongly, with increases of +13.7%, +9.6% and +6.3% respectively. While we welcome the fact that arrivals from Britain are up +1%, the impact of Brexit on outbound travel from Britain is still a concern.

Tourism Ireland outlined its marketing plans for 2019 earlier this week, aiming to ensure that the island of Ireland continues to increase its share of the global travel business.
